
COMMISSION: 25% commission charged on all sales and all commercial activity conducted within and enabled by the use of the Gallery including:

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Exhibitor agrees that:

- a. 10% of the hire fee and bond combined must be paid within 30 days of notification of successful application and receipt of tax invoice from the gallery.
- b. The remaining 90% hire fee must be paid at least 60 days before installation of exhibition.
- c. An Exhibition booking is not confirmed until 10% deposit is received by the gallery.
- d. All Exhibitors must have their own Public Liability Insurance and provide a copy.
- e. A Risk Assesment Form must be completed after Induction by the Gallerist, before exhibition installation.
- f. Gallery will provide exhibition booking form with key dates for provision by artist of marketing material and exhibition collateral.
- 2. A 25% commission is charged by the gallery on sales made during an exhibition and includes all commercial activity conducted within and enabled by the use of the Gallery including but not limited to: Any activity which creates an income or profit from the activity eg. Art sales, fee paying classes & workshops, door entry, or prepaid fee.
- 3. Exhibitions associated with financial or in-kind sponsorship, festivals, touring exhibitions and commercial events are strictly by arrangement and written agreement with the Gallerist on behalf of the Lone Goat Gallery Board of Management. - 4. SQUARE Point of Sale facility is used for all sales at the gallery.
- 5. No subletting of the exhibition space is permitted.
- 6. All artworks will be hung exclusively using the dedicated hook and wire system.
- 7. Artist will present artworks ready to hang with D-rings, according to supplied specifications
- 8. The use of the Gallery space will be restricted to the purpose of the application, for exhibtion and associated agreed public programs.
- 9. Cancellations by the Exhibitor must be received by email. Verbal cancellations will not be accepted. In the event of cancellation by the Exhibitor, the following applies:
- a. More than 180 days (six months) from commencement of the hire period: the deposit paid (10%) is returned.
- b. Less than 180 days from the commencement of the hire period: the deposit is forfieted.
- c. Less than 60 days from the commencement of the hire period: the remainder of the hire fee paid will only be refunded if the gallery is rebooked for the same period at this short notice.
- $10. \ The \ Gallery \ provides \ Volunteers \ to \ open, \ close, \ and \ invigilate \ / \ sit \ the \ space \ at \ all \ times.$

11. The Exhibitor or Exhibitor(s) are responsible for:

- a. Cost of insurance of work in transit and for the duration of the exhibition.
- b. The installation of all art work in consultation with the Gallerist.
- c. Note that works are exhibited at the Exhibitor's own risk. Stolen, lost or damaged items are entirely the responsibility of the exhibitor.
- d. Loss of or damage to their personal equipment.
- e. The promotion of their exhibition in consultation with the Gallerist.
- f. Opening night costs Catering and refreshments, entertainment or other as specified by the Exhibitor
- g. Cost of optional printed postcards and promotional banners. Gallery can provide subsidised cost printing of banners and postcards on gallery templates.
